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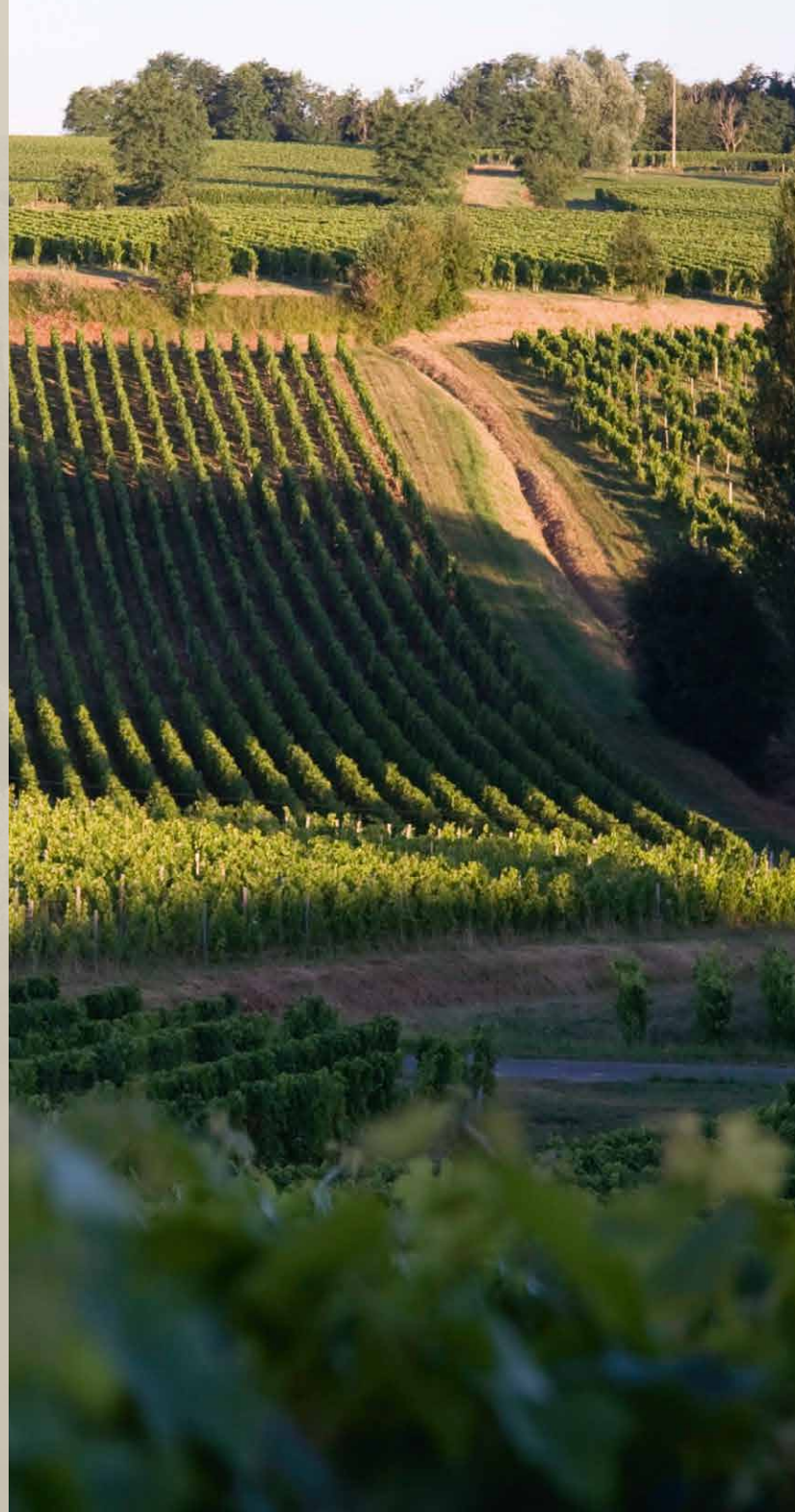


Located on the right bank of the Gironde in Saint-Christophe-de-Double, Château du Bois Chantant is a beautiful property spread over an area of **44 hectares**. The vineyard is planted with **Merlot (86%), Petit Verdot (6%), Cabernet Franc (5%) et Cabernet Sauvignon (3%)**. The **twenty-year old vines** benefit from a range of soil types (clay, silt, sand).

REASONED VITICULTURE

Keen to respect the environment and our terroir we have put several measures into action. Certain plots are allowed to lie fallow in order to maintain ecological reservoir zones. This ancient technique **offers a two-fold advantage in so much that it allows the development of the biodiversity whilst at the same time favouring a reduction in the use of fertilizers.** We also observe the vine closely so that we only need to apply the treatments which are strictly necessary.

A great deal of work is undertaken in the vineyard to obtain the best grape quality at the optimum ripeness at harvest time.



HIGH-PRECISION WORK

The grapes harvested are sorted then vinified according to traditional methods in stainless steel thermoregulated vats in order to preserve freshness and fruit aromas.



On top of the quality of both the terroir and the vines comes the great competence in mastering the traditional and innovative techniques applied by Vincent Cachau, the Chateau's oenologist.
